Memorandum of Understanding Between the Leon County School District and Leon County Teachers Association

This memorandum is written to serve as an agreement between the Leon County School District and the Leon County Teachers Association.

1. COVID-19 Paid Leave

Leon County School District will offer up to ten (10) days of paid leave to all eligible employees related to COVID-19 during the 2021-22 school year. All of the following criteria must be met to be eligible:

- i. Board-hired in a leave-eligible position,
- ii. Test positive for COVID-19, experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, or directed by the Covid Czar to get tested and waiting for test results,
- iii. COVID-19 paid leave may be used only for the specific duration of the quarantine period, not to exceed ten (10) days of the prior paid leave.
- iv. Prior to the allocation of COVID-19 paid leave, the employee must submit a written note from a medical provider and/or a Covid Czar indicating either the employee is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 or has tested positive for COVID-19 with the date of the positive result of the test.

Additional Terms:

- i. COVID-19 paid leave applies only to the employee's health conditions and does not include other reasons, such as the illness of or to provide care for children or other family members.
- ii. Employees must submit a COVID-19 Paid Leave Request and required documentation to the Human Resources Department in order to be allocated additional days of COVID-19 paid leave no later than 30 calendar days upon return to work for leave reimbursement.
- iii. This COVID-19 paid leave availability will be retroactive to July 1, 2021.
- iv. Required documentation must be submitted each time if an employee must quarantine due to COVID-19 symptoms or a COVID-19 positive diagnosis.
- v. If an employee uses all ten (10) days of the COVID-19 paid leave, the employee will be required to use accrued sick leave, compensatory time or unpaid leave.

This agreement will be in effect until June 30, 2022.
