







Q5 How aware are you that \$12 to \$18 million is being rolled over yearly for school sites?





Q6 How aware are you that an additional \$5 million above state requirements is rolled over each year by Leon County Schools?





Q7 LCS should show urgency in providing educators with a fair salary increase.





Q8 Rank the following in priority for you.




